OVERVIEW: To oversee and lead the ministry of the camp, including program, facility and services, as well as serve as the primary ambassador for camp.

AMENABLE TO: The Alabama-West Florida Conference Bishop and CORE Team

OUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. At least 21 years of age.
- 2. Deep Christian faith consistent with the Theology and Social Values of the United Methodist Church
- 3. Vision, energy and passion for camp and retreat ministry in rural and outdoor settings.
- 4. Creative programming skills including experience and ability to hire, train, supervise and lead staff.
- 5. Management skills to include financial, operational and staffing.
- 6. Interpersonal skills with staff, church leaders and camp visitors.
- 7. Organizational skills to oversee building and grounds, and food service.
- 8. Welcoming spirit of radical hospitality with a passion for quality, mission driven ministry.
- 9. Bachelor's Degree in related areas (or equivalent experience and training).
- 10. Availability to live on site and give oversight to the campground and its operations.
- 11. Ability to physically move about the campground with auditory and visual acuity to identify and respond to any situation.
- 12. Ability to work with and communicate effectively with groups and individuals of varied ages.
- 13. Basic computer skills to include Microsoft Office and email.

RESPONSIBILITIES AND DUTIES

General oversight for the entire ministry of the Blue Lake United Methodist Assembly Grounds to include facilities, programs, staff, food service, summer camp, group ministries, administration, visioning, and all other work needed to provide a holy place of camp and retreat ministry.

- 1. Solicit, prepare for, host and serve groups who contract the use of camp.
- 2. Promote the Blue Lake Camping Ministry to local churches, fostering partnerships in ministry, throughout the conference, to the local community and to other potential groups.
- 3. Recruit, interview and hire camp staff, with input from the Board of Trustees and relevant staff leadership.
- 4. Train, supervise, and evaluate staff and their work to include a clear understanding and adherence to the core values.
- 5. Be responsible for the administrative and operational needs of Blue Lake United Methodist Assembly.
- 6. Ensure that the total camp and all facilities are consistently safe, well-maintained, and appealing. Ensure that the site is operated in compliance with local, state and federal regulations (food service, health, etc.) and in compliance with the applicable standards of The American Camp Association (ACA).
- 7. Keep abreast of developments in outdoor and retreat ministry and identify resources.
- 8. Maintain compliance with and accreditation documentation for the American Camp Association.
- 9. Oversee health care and health care policies and procedures.
- 10. Collaborate with the Program Director to create, plan, and oversee summer camping programs in relation to the annual conference, local church partnerships and other groups that may partner with us to offer summer camp.
- 11. Cultivate and engage the fundraising donor base and act as chief fundraiser.
- 12. Develop and initiate plans for marketing and public relations
- 13. Other items:
